Guidelines for Poster Preparation

Poster presentations offer an opportunity to showcase your research, aiding in its publicity and discussion generation. A successful poster constitutes a visually engaging presentation that highlights and summarizes the primary aspects of your research. The presenter will furnish additional details in person at the exhibition.

Poster Specifications:

- **Poster size:** A1 size (594 x 841 mm). Please adhere strictly to the provided format. Also leave out 1 inch (25.4 mm) margin from both left and right sides of the template.
- **Font:**
 - Use easily readable fonts with a minimum font size of 20 pt.
 - Suggested minimum font sizes:
 - Title: 36 pt.
 - List of authors: 25 pt.
 - Avoid using more than 2-3 font styles.
- **Color:** Choose colors carefully to match with the given poster format.
- **Poster content:**
 - The paper title, along with all authors and their affiliations should be stated at the top of the poster. Please refer to the following format when specifying author affiliations.

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- The poster should be structured with the following components: introduction, materials and methods, data and results, conclusions and future work, references, and acknowledgements.
- **Before sending the electronic copy of the research poster:**
 1. Confirm poster is well organized and easy to read.
 2. Check for spelling and grammatical errors.
 3. Check each text box to ensure there is no overlapping of text and boxes.
 4. Confirm there are no pixelated images.
 5. Confirm all references and citations have been noted.
